The exceptions enumerated in this Section shall be strictly and narrowly construed. Whenever possible, the school employee responsible for the meeting shall apply the general rule prohibiting recording.● Recording by responsible school staff. When recording requested by a parent is permitted under any exception enumerated in this Section, the school employee responsible for the meeting shall make arrangements to record the meeting by similar means. Such recording shall be part of the education record of the child, subject to all laws pertinent to such records. <p>As used in this Guideline, the term “parent” shall include a biological or foster parent or legal guardian of the child, a person acting as a parent of the child, or any advisor or representative acting on behalf of any person identified herein as a parent.</p>
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
