

	<p>Forces and who has continuously maintained the school district as his/her legal residence will be presumed to have a district domicile.</p> <p>Examples of factors which may provide convincing evidence include the following:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Lease or purchase of a permanent independent residence.2. Payment of appropriate state and local taxes.3. Pennsylvania driver's license with address within the district and/or automobile registration.4. Agreement for permanent full-time employment.5. Membership in social, civic, political, athletic and/or religious organizations located within the school district.6. Registration to vote within the school district.7. Statement of intention to reside indefinitely in the school district.8. Statement from the parent(s)/guardian(s) of a minor setting forth facts to establish the minor's financial independence and separate residence. <p>Each case will be decided on the basis of all facts submitted, with qualitative rather than quantitative emphasis. No given number of factors is required for domicile, since the determination in each case is one of the subjective intention of the student to reside in the school district for an unlimited time.</p> <p>State Board of Education rules and regulations require that local, continuous tuition support be provided for students who move permanently from one sponsoring school district, as defined in the Articles of Agreement, to another. Therefore, the district will consider domicile in another Lehigh County Community college sponsoring district to be part of the continuous period of residency eligibility requirement for a student who permanently moves from another sponsoring school district to the Southern Lehigh School District.</p>
