

# Features of...

## Expository Writing- Descriptive

- It has four forms:

### **Imaginative Description-**

- It may sound like poetry.
- It uses figurative language.
- It appeals to the senses.

### **Factual Description-**

- It shares facts, not opinions.
- It describes objects and processes clearly.
- It uses content vocabulary/words that fit the topic.

### **Narrative Description-**

- It describes a sequence of events.
- It uses action verbs and descriptive phrases to paint a scene and convey emotion.

### **Realistic Description-**

- It tells about one event or situation that really happened.
- It describes things as they really happened so that the reader can understand.
- It uses colorful but specific language.

- All forms have a topic sentence, body, and conclusion.
- The voice, tone, and mood of each piece changes to match the audience and the purpose for writing.
