## Introduction

State your topic sentence. This is the sentence that defines the subject of the whole piece and tells the reader some general information about it. (You may use a short attention-grabber if it directly relates to the topic. You may create a list of upcoming topics that will be discussed.)

## Body

- 1. Write one paragraph for each of the main ideas that relate to the topic. Each paragraph should have its own main idea sentence that tells about the topic.
- 2. The remaining sentences in the paragraph should include specific examples and quotes from the literature that support your topic sentence (the proof).
- 3. If it is appropriate to your topic, include specific relevant personal experiences.

## Conclusion

The conclusion is the final paragraph of a response to literature. Restate the topic and show the reader that you have a thorough understanding of the text.
