# **Future plans for Lower Milford Elementary School**

  - 3. Sell building, Mr. Bolasky (a local realtor) appraised the building at \$250,000. Push the Rock, a faith based nonprofit organization had an interest in touring the building for possible purchase if the building usage will be changes, all has to be brought up to code, which would become very expensive.
