Replaces former policy 5117	206. ASSIGNMENT WITHIN DISTRICT
1. Purpose	The Board directs that the assignment of students to classes and schools within this district shall be consistent with the educational needs and abilities of students and best use of district resources.
2. Authority SC 1310 Pol. 103	The Southern Lehigh School District shall be considered one attendance area for the purpose of assignment of students.
3. Delegation of Responsibility	The Superintendent, with the approval of the Board, has the responsibility for assigning students to particular schools. In assigning students to schools within this district, the Superintendent shall not discriminate on the basis of race, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, ancestry, or handicap/disability.
	The Superintendent shall periodically review existing school assignments and recommend to the Board changes that may be justified. Current practices and procedures are based on: • consideration of safe student transportation and travel
	convenience of access to schools
	financial and administrative efficiency
	effectiveness of the instructional program.
	The Superintendent or designee shall assign incoming transfer students to schools, grades, and classes that afford each student the greatest likelihood of realizing full educational potential.
	The building principal shall assign students in his/her school to appropriate grades, classes, or groups. This action shall be based on consideration of the needs and abilities of the student as well as the administration of the school.
4. Guidelines	In general, the assignment of students to elementary schools in the district shall be made based on several factors:

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
