Academic Proficiency:

- AP-2: On Dec. 3, an acting troupe from the Young Expressions Performing Arts, directed by Mrs. Nedra Fritzinger, presented "The Three Bully Goats Gruff" to students at Lower Milford. The play had a "bullying" theme
- AP-2/HQT-2: LB Rtl Discipline Team has completed its second training and is now working on developing a plan to teach students the expected behaviors when the plan is rolled out next school year.
- AP-2: Hopewell held a school-wide CARES celebration in recognition of student school community earning 200 points/ rewards/ compliments
- AP-3 / AP-8: An IS/MS meeting to discuss the program knows as Rigorous LA was conducted recently. Improvements to the course and criteria for participation were the focus.
- AP-3: Author/illustrator/musician Daryl Cobb shared his books and music, along with his passion for writing. His entertaining
 program also gave Lower Milford students an experience with the creative writing process.
- Veterans Day activities were held at all elementary buildings to honor local veterans.
- AP-8: 4Sight #2 has been given (grades 5-8 and 11) and is in the process of scoring and data input. Elementary common writing assessments are in process and inter-rater reliability scoring meetings are being arranged.
- AP-8: Elementary teachers from all buildings will be meeting on Monday, December 21st, to review new math text books as they
 continue their curriculum review process.

Students and their families will be having breakfast with Santa and Mrs. Claus as well as have the opportunity to shop for their families, take part in holiday games, and make crafts to take home.

Highly Qualified Teachers:

- HQT-1: Lower Milford is finalizing plans for a school wide "Math Camp" on December 9. This day extended from staff development
 emphasis on better utilizing Compass Learning lessons in our math classes. Compass Learning has collaborated with us to plan a
 day that will be engaging and instructional for our students, but has the greater purpose of modeling the integration of Compass
 Learning with our math lessons and math "center time." Follow-ups will occur at faculty meetings and grade level meetings to
 enhance this professional development opportunity at the building level a further effort to move us toward greater understanding
 and implementation of Gold Seal Lessons at the primary level.
- HQT-1: Completed 1st round interview for Multimedia technician. Two dynamic candidates sent on to 2nd round interview being scheduled for 12.11.09
- HTQ-1, 2, 4, & 5: HS Reform team Kick-Off meeting will be held Dec. 16.
