Lighting System

Requested by Mr. Markley last year for the third grade play. The sound system was purchased, but we waited on the lighting system.

Mr. Markley is returning to do 3rd grade play next year.

Discussed that we could use the box tops money for this.

Melinda asked for questions, there were no questions.

Art Show/Bingo

This is a school hosted event, not a PTA event.

Ms. McDonnell presented her idea of having a company come in and set up student artwork in frames for purchase. Each frame costs \$19 and whatever the school wants to add. (the company gets \$19 per frame) They do all set up and take down.

Ms. McDonnell is thinking about charging \$20 or \$25 per frame. She would use the proceeds for the art program. She would like to do a mosaic mural outside using tiles. She would need to purchase tiles.

There was a question if you could purchase just the frame so parents could use it for other children's art work in the home. Ms. McDonnell will look into that.

There was discussion about how long to have for art show and when to start bingo night. Ms. McDonnell was thinking 6-8:30 for the whole event. Either .5 hour or 1 hour for art show at the very beginning of the night.

Discussion around food. Parents suggested keeping it simple. Water and popcorn.

We talked about being able to take credit cards. Kyle Gangwere is going to look into getting that capability.

Ms. McDonnell will need 2 people at the purchasing table to collect money and place the frame/picture in orange bag to identify what frames are paid for.

Ms. McDonnell noted that she can always use help setting up for the art show if any parent have some extra time to help.

<u>Vote</u>

It was determined that despite the light turnout we could still have a general vote, as there were a reasonable number of people being that it was January meeting and it was rescheduled due to weather. It was publicly advertised that we would be voting today on PTA's facebook page.

Voted on increase \$200 to budget to host Frozen movie. Passed unanimously.

Voted on increase in the budget by \$200 to host Family fun night. Vote passed unanimously.

Voted on budget change to purchase lighting system. Increase to budget it \$4000 Passed unanimously.

Voted on increasing passport to the world from \$250 to \$500. Passed unanimously.

Voted to increase expense for outdoor classroom from \$7500 to \$10500. Passed Unanimously.
