Dear Hopewell Families:

Happy Spring everyone! It's nice to see warm weather is just around the corner. Our calendar will start to fill up quickly with events and activities to finish out the 2015-16 school year.

Classroom placements for next school year:

Please understand that each year we receive requests from parents to have their child placed with a specific teacher. Unfortunately, we cannot honor this type of request. Academic and social factors are the primary determinants in the placement decisions for every child. When planning for our next school year, the principal, psychologist, reading specialist, instructional support teacher, and classroom teachers review the strengths and needs of <u>each</u> child in our school. This is a process that takes hours of work and discussion. Parents having unique placement concerns about their child are invited to share their thoughts in writing to the principal by May 1st.

Please be advised I do not provide individual responses to these letters but accept parental input for informational purposes only. Central office and our transportation department do not finalize school assignments until August since they attempt to balance the enrollment numbers in classrooms between our schools. Therefore, student assignments within our building are not finalized and will not be available until 2 weeks before the start of the school year. Thank you for your understanding.

Student footwear:

As warm weather approaches, we'd like to remind parents that appropriate footwear is requested for school. While flip-flops are easy to slide off and on, they tend to break easily and result in more student injuries at school. During physical education, students are required to wear sneakers. For recess, students are required to wear secure footwear with straps. Your cooperation is appreciated.

Spring safety reminder:

We are in the process of reviewing school-wide safety expectations with our students. This seems to be necessary each spring when our weather improves. Please have a discussion with your child about our Hopewell CARES philosophy and encourage your child to "Be Nice and Be Safe" at all times. All words should be nice and make others feel comfortable, and all actions should be safe so no one gets hurt. This is necessary on the bus, classroom, cafeteria, playground and lavatories. Please ask your child to explain the safety responsibilities in these areas and why they're important for everyone!

New building update:

We are continuing to plan for the opening of our new school for the 2016-17 school year. Everything is still on schedule. Please stay tuned for more updates.

Once next year's school calendar is submitted and approved by our school board we can share some information about student orientations that will occur before the first day of school. Please keep in mind the new building will be new for all of us. Please be assured we'll be practicing and learning new routines for many weeks into the new school year.
