Academic Proficiency:

- AP 1.1: Initial Keystone exam scores have been received and the high school teachers are analyzing the student data.
- AP 1.1: DIBELS and AIMSweb data is being utilized to monitor student growth and to plan for the appropriate intervention programs.
- AP 1.1: Elementary buildings participated in Read Across America Day with a variety of literacy activities.
- AP 2.2: Parent teacher conferences are being held in grades K 6.
- AP 3.8: The MS Design 21 class has been in contact with both the South Africa project and Sweden as part of their projects.
- AP 6.1: As part of the March 1st professional development day, K 6 teachers participated in technology fair.
- AP 6.1: The technology department expanded Spartandocs to include a closed blog for teachers to use with students for collaborative projects.
