Dr. Beiber shared some areas they are exploring including the potential to accept more properly credentialed teachers for Adjunct status in order to expand dual enrollment offerings to high school

students. LCCC is currently engaged in a search for a new President and that process going well. Our LCCC representatives, Mr. Mohr and Mr. Miracle are working on our behalf to ensure a great outcome of that search.

 LCTI will be launching a new seniors-only Biotechnology program next year that is designed like the current Emerging Health and Emerging Engineering programs. Students will earn college credit and have internship experiences in local businesses that involve biotechnology careers- an area that is quickly growing.
