F. Elected Tax Collector Compensation

The Administration recommends the following changes to the compensation schedule that is currently in place for the elected tax collectors:

- 1. Increase the rate paid per bill for the first 2000 parcels per municipality from \$2.46 to \$2.56 for 2014 and adjust by 3% annually for the following three years.
- 2. Increase the rate paid per bill for any parcels in excess of 2000 per municipality from \$1.65 to \$1.75 for 2014 and adjust by 3% annually for the following three years.

A. Lehigh Valley Cooperative Purchasing Council Vehicle Fuel

The Administration recommends a one year extension for the joint purchase of vehicle fuels with the Lehigh Valley Cooperative Purchasing Council. Both contractors, Isobunkers, LLC of Aston, PA and Petroleum Traders Corporation, Fort Wayne, IN, have agreed to hold all diesel and gasoline margins for final year of the contract.
