Academic Proficiency:

- AP-1.1: IS PVAAS data meetings were conducted by the principals with each grade level team to review the results of student growth.
- AP 1.1: Work has begun to develop a plan for students who did not pass the Keystone exam that is required for graduation.
- AP 8: A group of teachers at the K 3 level began the process of reviewing our reading curriculum to align it with the PA Core Standards.
- AP 2.2: K 6 held it's annual Parent Visitation Day.

Highly Qualified Staff:

- HQ 1.1: District staff attended a second day of training on the Core Standards from Discovery Education.
- HQ 1.1: The Food Service department had their annual Food Safety and Sanitation Training so that all staff are up to date on their requirements.
- HQ 1.4: Staff from the MS participated in training of effective reading strategies through Reading Apprenticeship.
- HQ 2.1: A team from LM and the IS had their first training in School Wide Positive Behavior Support. There will be three additional trainings throughout the year.
- HQ 5.1: Administrators attended a day of training on the Core Standards from Discovery Education geared specifically towards their roles.

Improved Communications:

- IC 2: IS administrators worked with Sapphire representatives to make revisions to IS report cards that would permit for easier grade, standards and comments entry by 4th and 5th grades staff, while also providing the capability to verify grades.
