

## Superintendent's Report

- The Administrative Team is finalizing plans to kick off the new school year. We met this
  morning to plan for opening week including opening day welcome, in-service day which
  will focus on PA Core Standards, building faculty meetings, new student orientations and
  building preparation time. Board members are invited to attend the Welcome Back
  breakfast and assembly next Tuesday, August 20 if available.
- Mrs. Mickley has Induction for new teachers planned. This begins Friday, August 16 and Board Members are invited to lunch on Friday, August 16, to meet our new teachers in the JPLIS cafeteria at 12:00 PM. Please let Diana Millman know if you plan to attend.
- As 2<sup>nd</sup> graders continue to register, our transportation department has juggled the numbers to limit class sizes at Lower Milford and Hopewell to a maximum of 25 and we've placed the overflow at Liberty Bell. By limiting the larger class sizes to one building we can provide additional support for two classes instead of 7 spaced throughout the district. Additional support at Liberty Bell will allow for class size reductions through flexible groupings and through extra adults in the classrooms. I am asking the Board for support of this plan.
- The Edu-Summit kicks off tomorrow at the high school. Board members are invited to stop by if available. The event has come together and we believe will be a valuable experience for the (approximately) 275 registered educators. Southern Lehigh has about one third of our teachers attending. Again, this is a great example of multi-district collaboration at no cost to any schools or participants.

- Russ Tucker, our DESIGN 21 teacher at the Intermediate School just returned from a 23 day trip to China where he taught English to Chinese children along with teachers from the UK and China. Russ took part in a partnership program with all expenses paid by the

Hebei Education Department, through a partnership that we established after I participated in the China Exchange program in 2011. Russ plans to share his experiences this year with our teachers and students.
