New Elementary School Building Project Financing

Mr. Jeremy Melber, Director of Business Services introduced Mr. Chris Gibbons of Concord Public Finance to discuss the General Obligation Bond, Series A 2009 to finance the New Elementary School Project and refinancing of current debt.

- District is interested in raising \$15,000,000 in net bond proceeds towards the Project
- District has the opportunity to refinance the General Obligation Bonds, Seriea A of 2009 for interest rate savaings. Under current market conditions, it is estimated the District could save a net of \$316,000 or 4.45% of refunded principal
