What do PSSA Scores Mean?

- Students are identified as performing in one of four levels: advanced, proficient, basic and below basic. The goal is for all students to be proficient or advanced – meaning that they have mastered Pennsylvania’s assessment anchor content standards at their grade level.

Advanced: This level reflects superior academic performance. Advanced work indicates an in-depth understanding and exemplary display of the skills included in the PA Academic Content Standards.

Proficient: Proficiency reflects satisfactory academic performance. Proficient work indicates a solid understanding and adequate display of the skills included in the Pennsylvania Academic Content Standards.

Basic: This level reflects marginal academic performance. Basic work indicates a partial understanding and limited display of the skills included in the PA Academic Content Standards. This work is approaching satisfactory performance, but has not been reached. There is a need for additional instructional opportunities and/or increased student academic commitment to achieve the proficient level.

Below Basic: The lowest level reflects inadequate academic performance. Below basic work indicates little understanding and minimal display of the skills included in the PA Academic Content Standards. There is a major need for additional instructional opportunities and/or increased student academic commitment to achieve the proficient level.

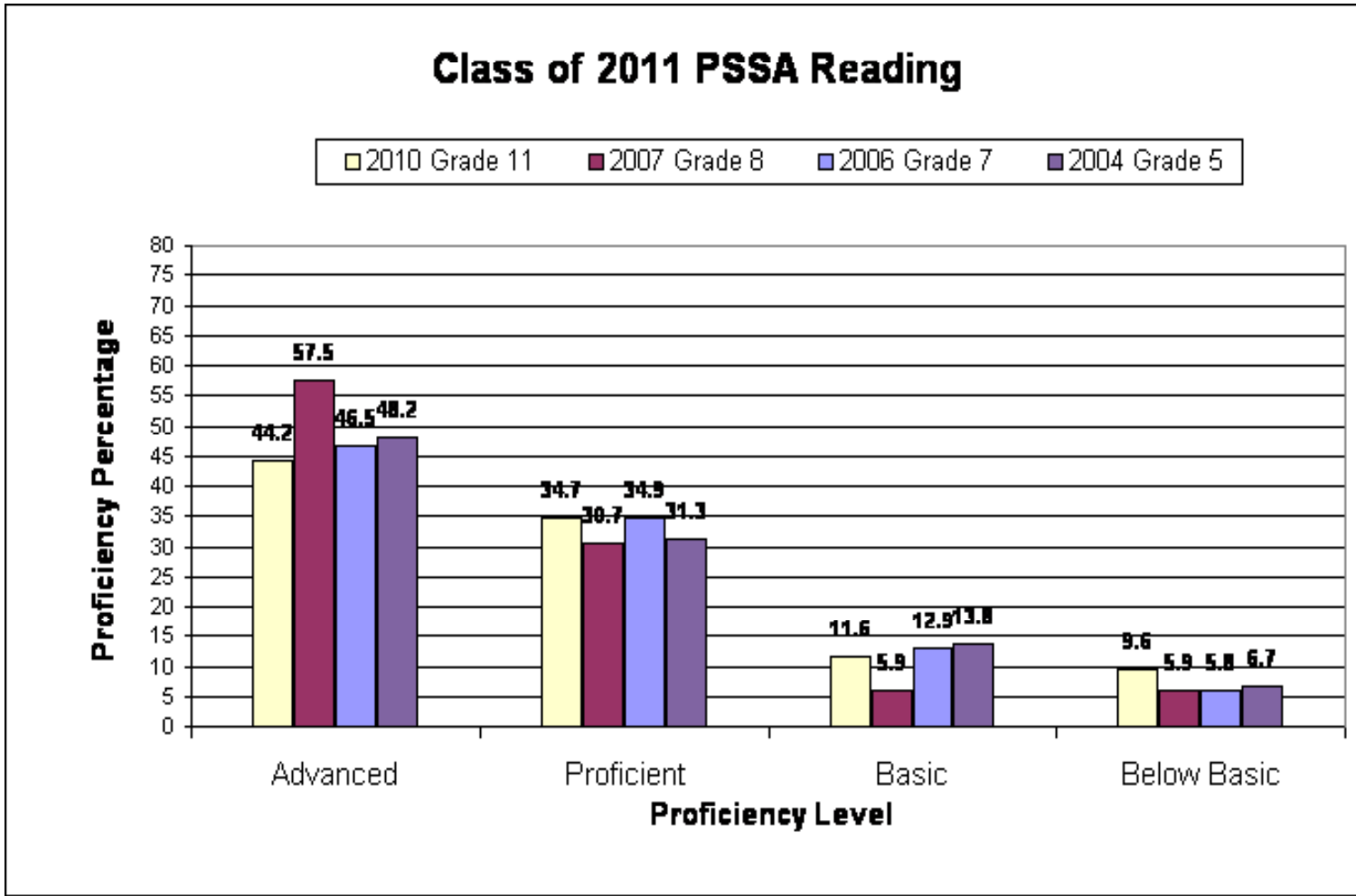

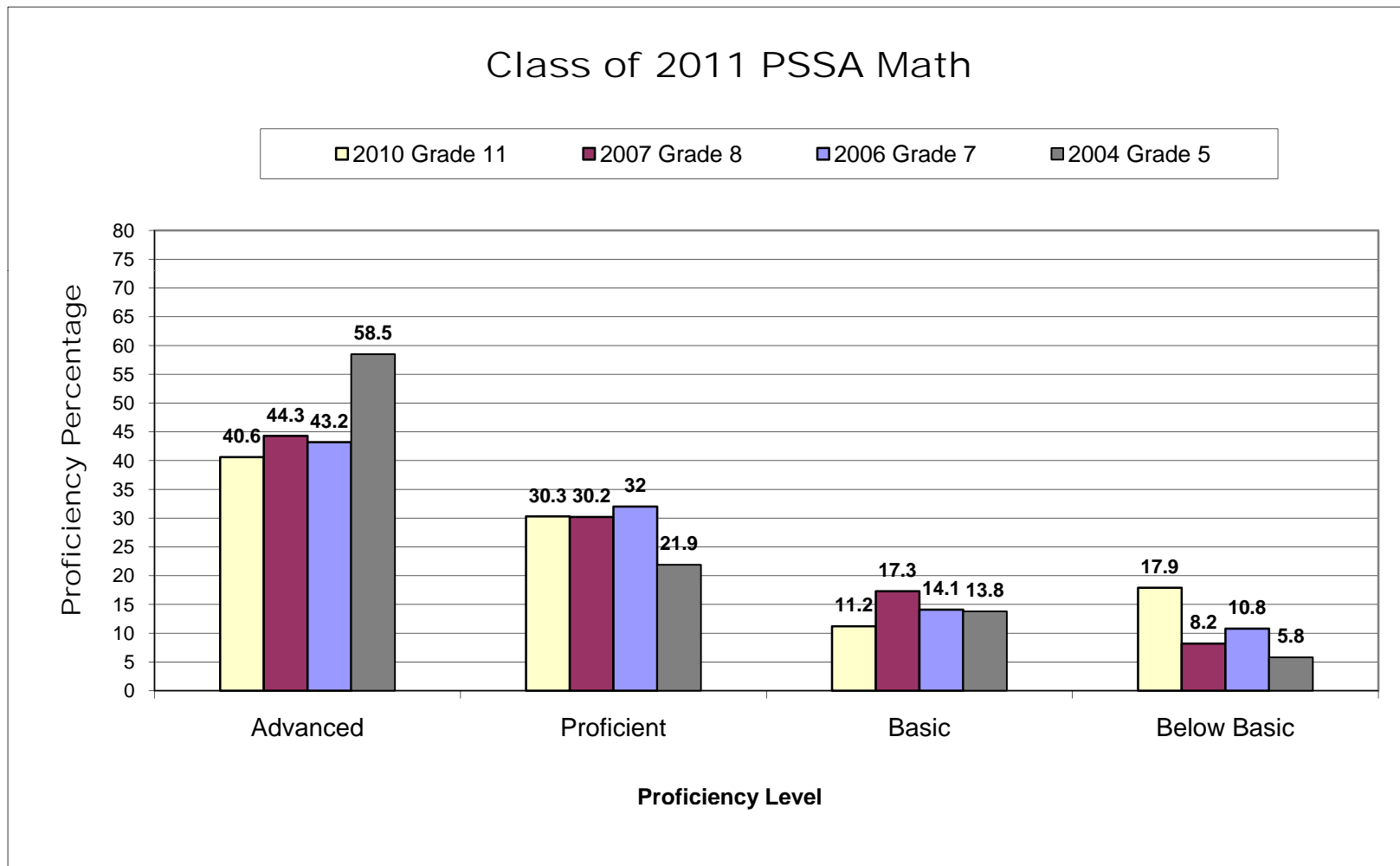

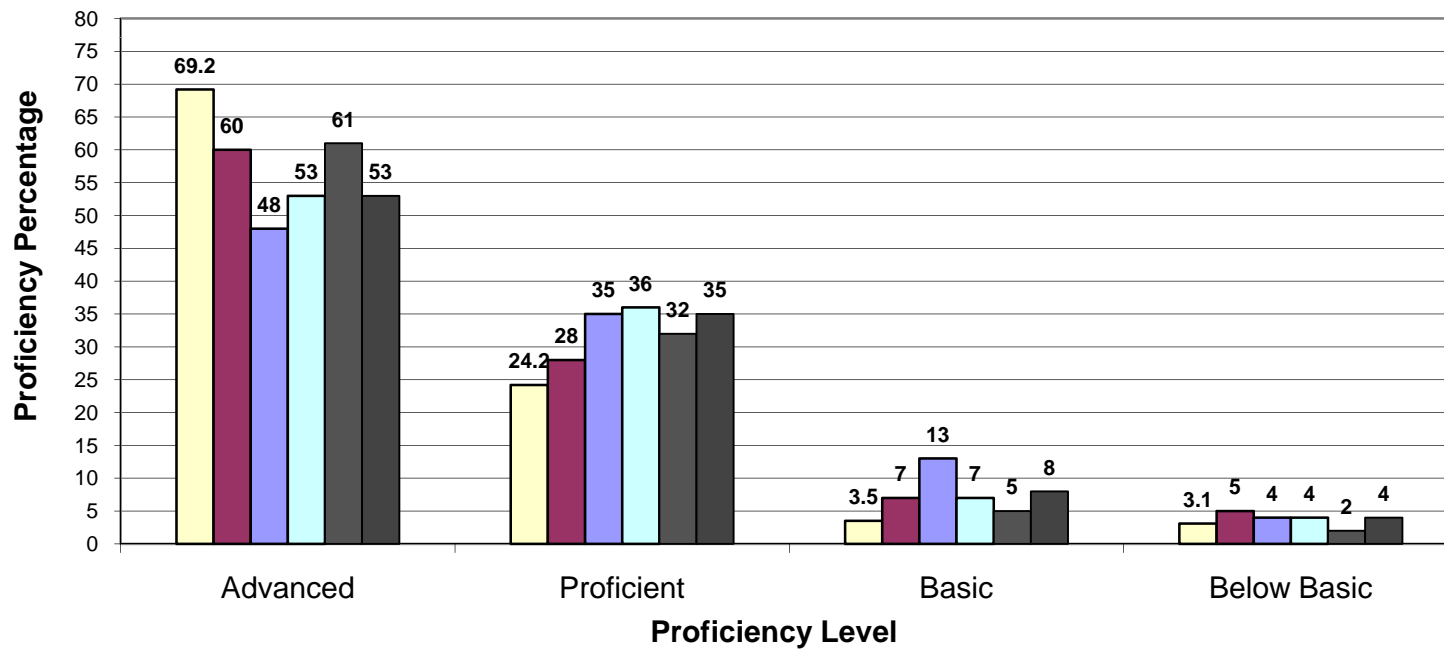

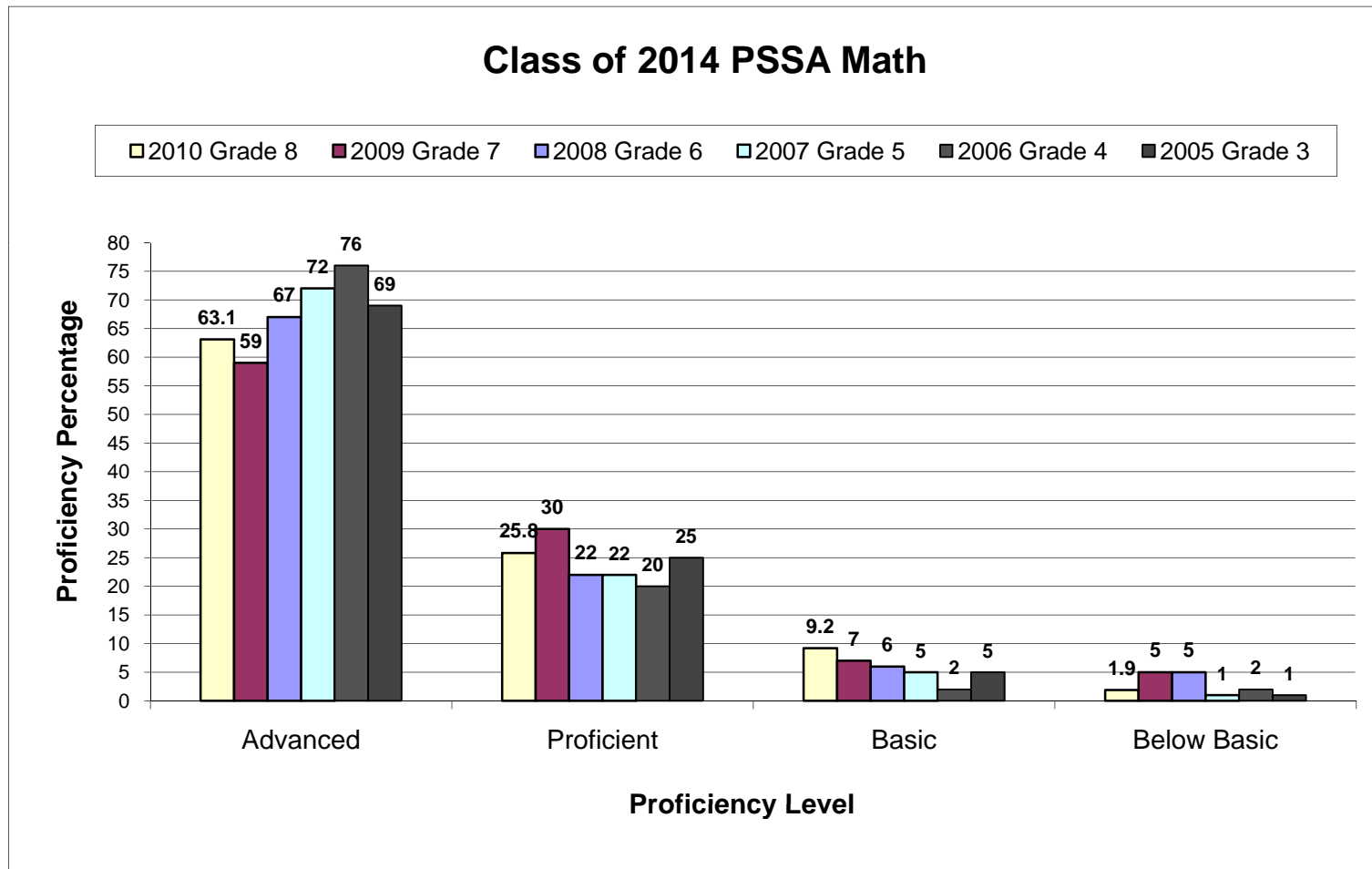

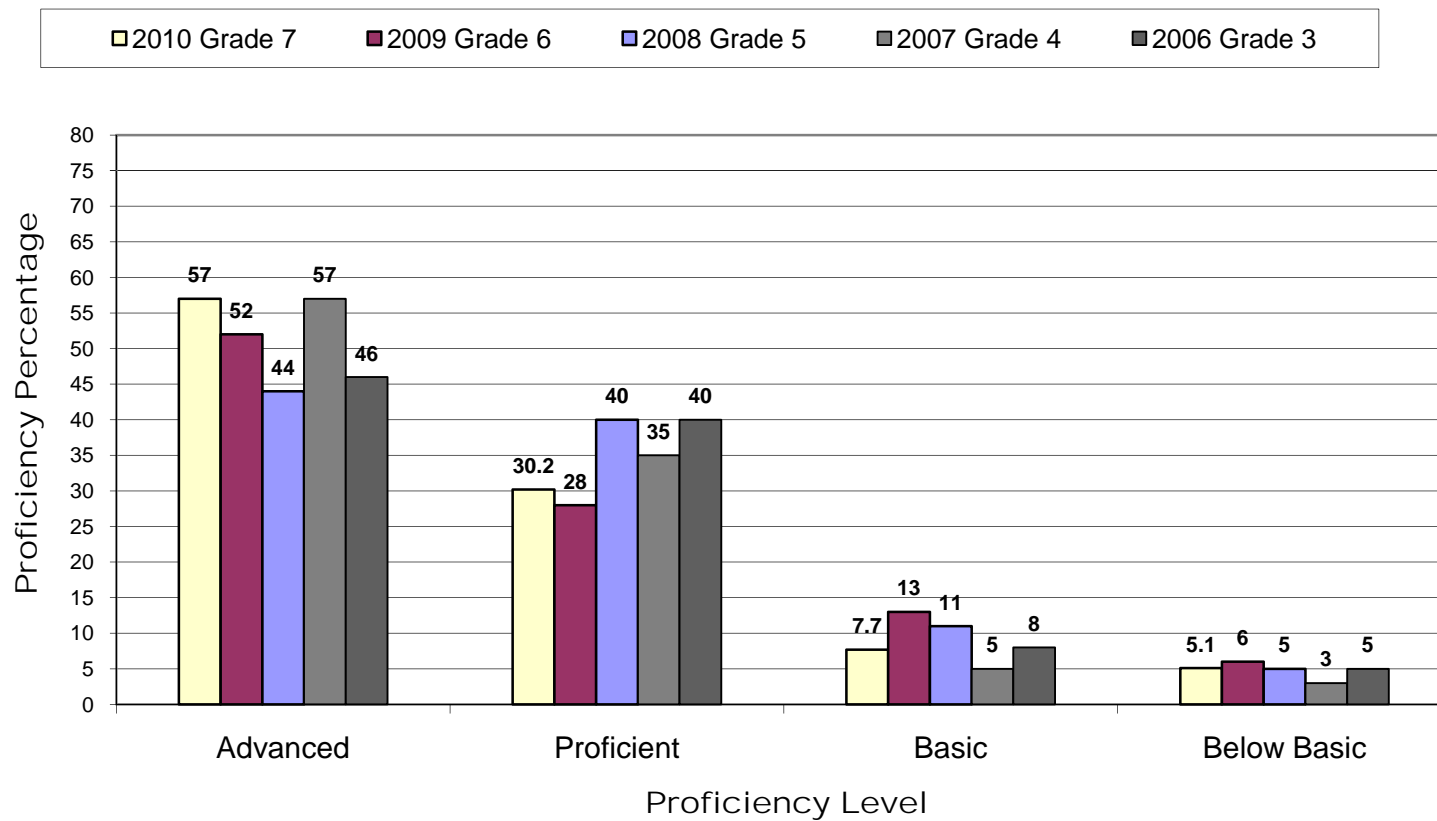
Tracking Class of 2014

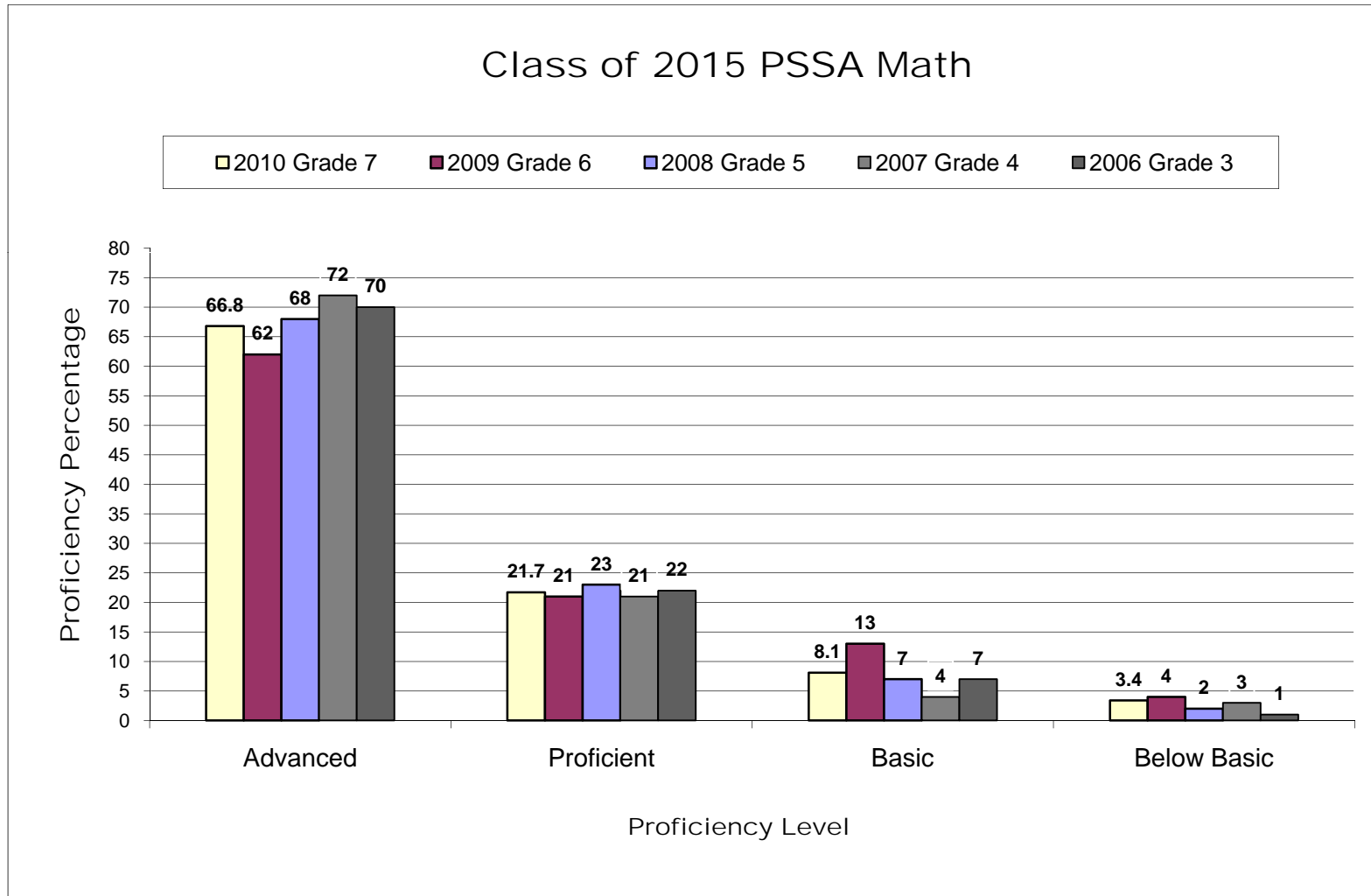

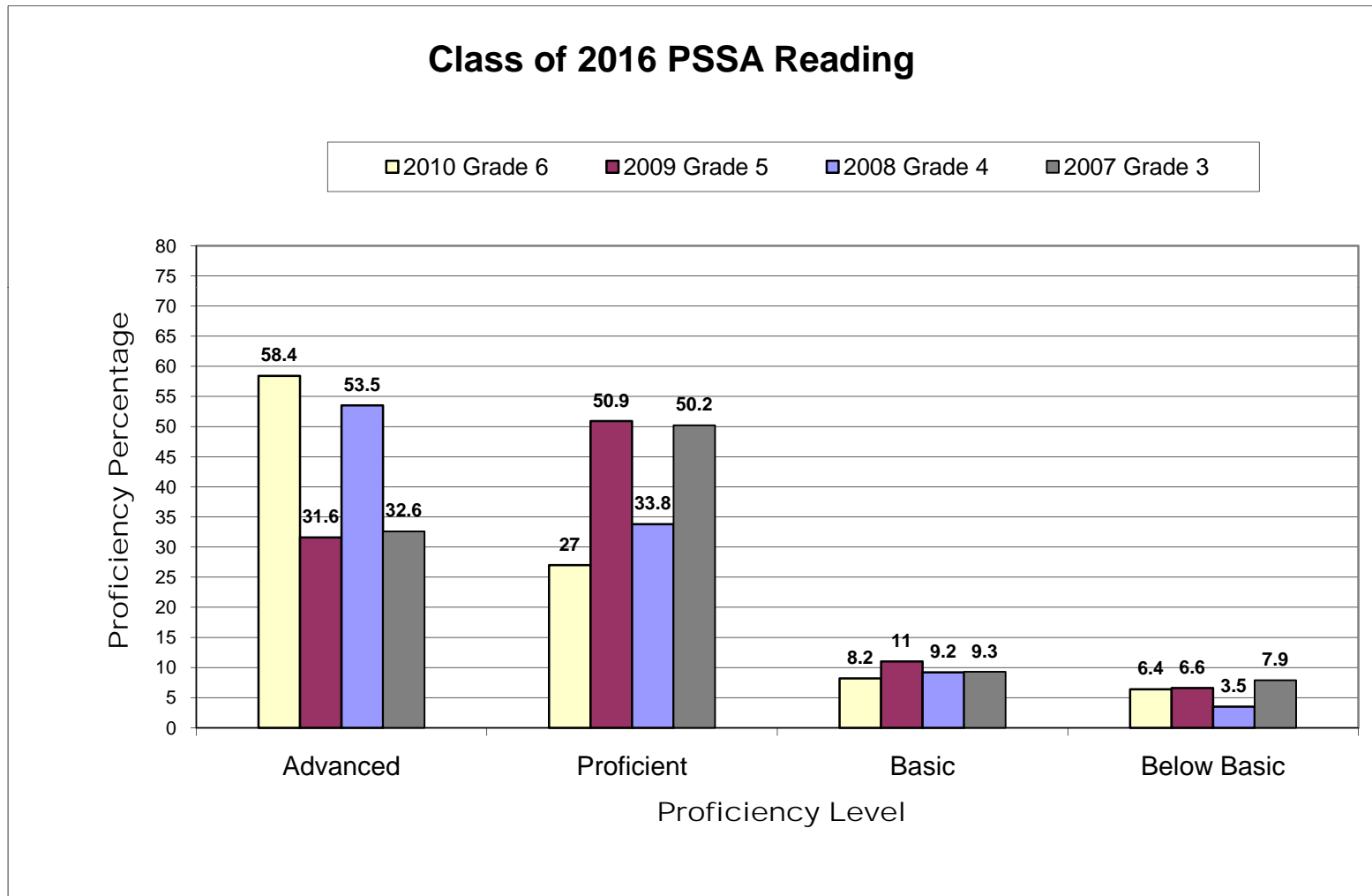

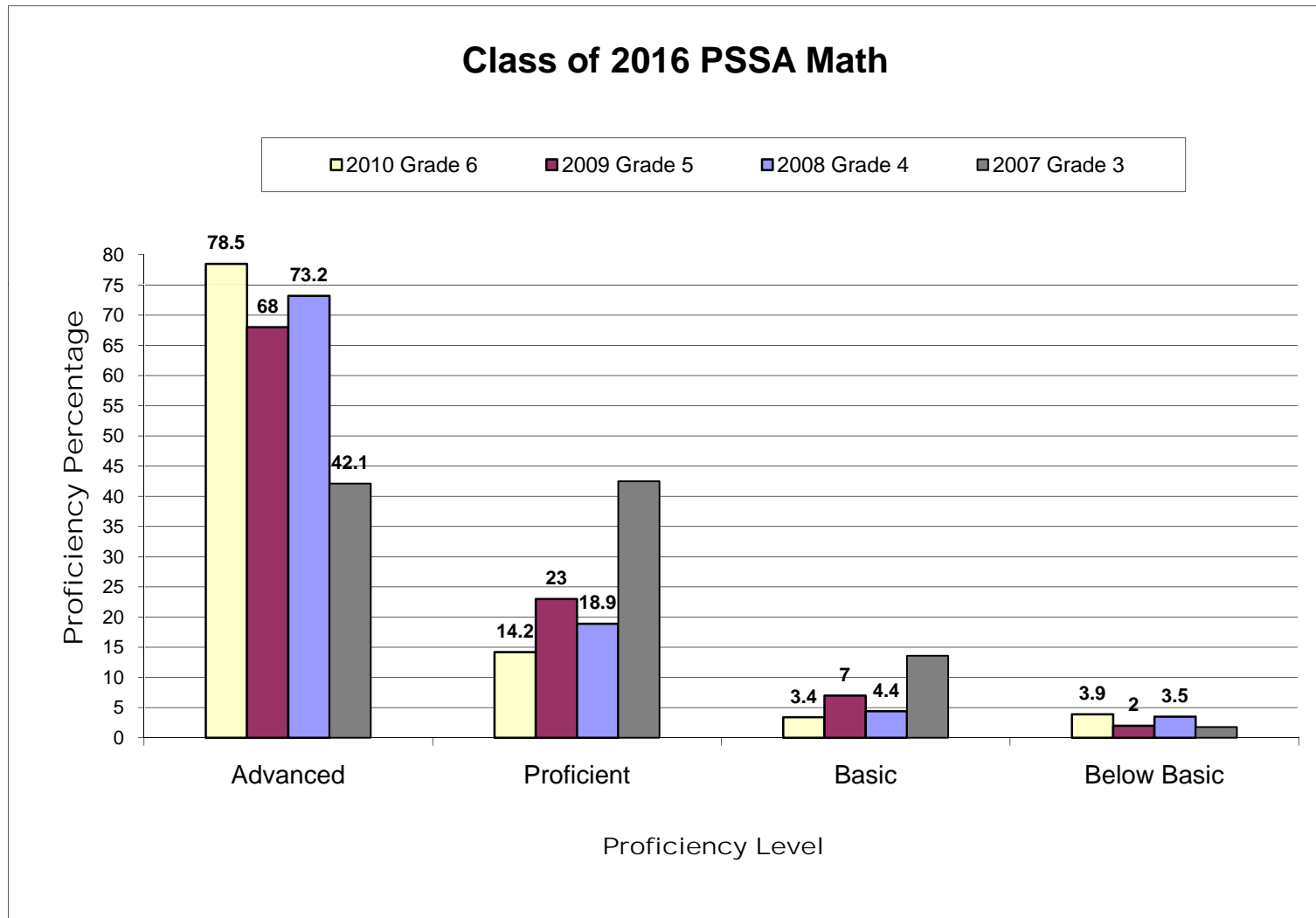

--PSSA Performance

- In every case, at least 80% of the elementary school students scored proficient or advanced on PSSA in reading, 88% in mathematics; 79% in writing, and 96% in science.
- We continue to see a dip in reading performance between grades 4 and 5. Fortunately, the scores go up again in grade 6 but it is still something we need to address.
- Writing continues to be an area where we need to strengthen our students performance. We invested in professional development in the area of writing last year and have more scheduled for this year.
