BUSINESS AND FINANCE

Chris Gibbons attended the Board meeting and provided the School Board with an update on a potential refunding of bond issue Series A of 2002. Mr. Gibbons explained that under current market conditions, the refunding of Series A of 2002 would yield a 3.82% present value savings as a percent of refunded principal, taking into consideration the costs of refunding. He also noted that because of the District's excellent bond rating, municipal bond insurance costs of approximately \$60,000 would not be incurred.
