Intermediate School report -

Staff participated in in-service events on Monday, January 17th. Instructional Assistants were provided a workshop given by SLIS school psychologist Brynne Rice concerning positive behavior strategies. Teachers were involved with workshops related to curriculum and assessment.

Much of the 4th grade student population has been selected for participation in the National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) in February. Preliminary assessment meetings have been completed with NAEP officials.

SLIS is also gearing up for the PSSA. For the good of all, testing begins with just 30.5 days remaining in our instructional calendar -- 1.5 days are devoted to in-service over the next two months, and two additional days are tied to the Presidents Day holiday. While we have great confidence in our students, and believe that SL will fair well comparatively in the state, it is important to realize that the timing of the 2011 PSSA is quite early. With only two-thirds of the year accomplished, it will be important to recognize that year-to-year comparative analysis of data may be difficult.

Elementary schools -

Currently in the mid-year testing process. Reading and Math common assessments have occurred over the last two weeks. We are completing the January DIBELS assessments. School cancellations and delays have forced us to adjust our testing schedule on a daily basis, but we are persevering! We will follow up with grade level data team meetings to discuss our results.

The elementary in-service day on January 17 focused on the new common core standards that are being rolled out. Teachers completed an activity in the math content area connecting the current state standards to the common cores that will replace them. We also matched the new math common cores to our math pacing guide. This activity was completed by each grade level team.

The end of the 2nd marking period is January 25. Elementary report card will be distributed on 2/4/11.

Lehigh Career & Technical Institute

Superintendent's Report

Four inclement weather days have been used so far this year. The Board has expressed an interest in looking at other dates besides the end of the school year should we exceed the five that are already scheduled.

The two hour delay today was due to the bus company not having sufficient buses to operate the Intermediate and Elementary bus runs. Mr. Swift from First Student was present and spoke to the Board about the issue. They are working to correct the problems that occurred that caused the buses to not function. Their plans include contacting the distributor regarding why the anti-gelling additive did not work in those fuel tanks, bringing employees in over a weekend to start buses and having employees report earlier on very cold days to ensure that all the buses will be operational.

Board members were recognized for their service to the School District.

Due to the cold weather there was low gas pressure coming into the main campus and as a result the High School, Middle School and Intermediate School were quite cold throughout the day.
