

Southern Lehigh School District Board of School Directors Meeting

CURRICULUM/STUDENT AND STAFF ACTIVITIES

Mr. Zuk, Mr. Davidson, Mrs. Farris, and Mr. Hafner reported on student and staff activities at the High School, Middle School, Intermediate School, and the elementary schools.

Mr. Zuk reported that 2 successful overseas student trips to Spain and Germany had returned prior to the spring break, and that the National Honor Society induction will be held tomorrow night in the auditorium.
