

## Superintendent's Report

- We need two Board members to help at graduation (Generally, this has been one male and one female).
- Reminder that Board Awards are scheduled for May 14, 2012, 7 PM in the High School Auditorium. Graduation is scheduled for June 1<sup>st</sup>, 6:30 PM in the High School Gymnasium. End of Year Celebration Assembly will be June 5<sup>th</sup> beginning at noon at the High School.
- We are exploring participation in the Pennsylvania Teacher and Principal Evaluation Project and PA's Race to the Top grant. Mrs. Lewis and I participated in a webinar with PDE and will be participating in another this week. The teacher evaluation is based upon Charlotte Danielson's work, which aligns with our current process. The principal evaluation model has not yet been disclosed but will align with the current Pennsylvania School Leadership Standards. These include 3 Core, and 6 Corollary standards. All of our Principals and I complete ongoing training (PA Inspired Leadership Series- PILS) related to these standards. We believe that the selected model will align with our current process, which is based on the Ten Dimensions of Leadership (Reeves) and we are hopeful that important details will be shared this week. PDE has indicated that all schools will be required to participate with the new evaluation system by 2013-2014. By participating in phase 3 and the RTT grant, we could secure funding for training that will not be available once the phase-in process is complete. Participation would allow our teachers and administrators to contribute to the decisions to determine student assessment data used as part of the process.
