Course Description:

The social studies Spanish Immersion program, for 7th Grade will focus on the study of Latin America, Asia, the Middle East and Africa. Even though this class is given 100% in Spanish, some English resources would be researched. We will meet on a daily basis and only the social studies knowledge and understanding will be assessed in this class. The students will be introduced to map skills, the five themes of geography, early inhabitants of the Americas, European exploration, conquest, colonization, and defeat, and human, physical, political geography of the regions above mentioned.
