


CREATING A NEW STUDYMATE ACTIVITY

Step 1: Make sure the **Edit Mode** is **ON** before you begin. The Edit Mode allows the instructor to edit content in his/her Blackboard course. This button is located in the upper right corner of the screen.



Step 2: Select the course content folder in which you want the StudyMate activity to be displayed.

Step 3: Click on the double-down arrows on the **Add Interactive Tool** button and select **StudyMate Class** from the menu.

Step 4: Create a title for your activity and set the editing rights. If you will allow students to edit their own work, then select the bubble “*Only the original author can edit their items*”. You can also check instructor items such as: *Once edited by the instructor, don't allow further editing (even by the original author)*. You can decide which items are important for your activity.

- ✓ 2. Choose your editing rights
- ✓ 3. When finished, click on **submit**

Step 5: Return to the course content folder and make sure that the StudyMate activity was successfully added to your course content.



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GRADE TAB

The **Grade** tab, which is only available to instructors, lists each student in the course who has accessed the StudyMate Class activity. Students who have not accessed StudyMate Class will not be listed in the Grade tab.
