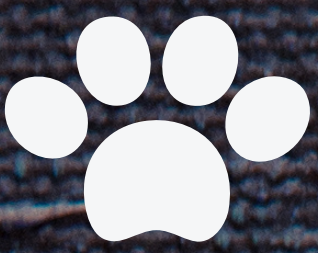

How do we encourage students to meet these expectations?

What is SWPBS?

- School-wide positive behavior support (SWPBS) is a proactive approach to teach, monitor, and support appropriate behavior for ALL students.
- The focus is on preventing student behavior problems across all school settings and creating a positive school climate.
- Behavioral expectations are explicitly taught to students by teachers through educational lessons throughout the school year.
- SWPBS is part of the continuum of academic and behavioral support provided through our Multi Tiered System of Supports.

How You Can Help

- Encourage your child to be respectful, responsible, and ready.
- Ask your child WHY the paw ticket was received. Offer praise for a job well done!
- Volunteer to help at our school store periodically.
