Ancillary Activities Workers support various operations throughout the Southern Lehigh SD, including, but not limited to, temporary instruction, building support, and support for programmatic as well as athletic events on an as-needed basis. Accordingly, these employees are approved for hire annually and all Ancillary Activities Workers must be approved by the Board of School Directors.

Some positions listed within this document may require additional skills or credentials to perform the roles and responsibilities of a given position successfully. APPLICATION PROCESS

Candidates interested in one or more Ancillary Activities Worker positions should visit the Southern Lehigh SD Employment Portal <<https://www.applitrack.com/sbsd/onlineapp/>> to submit an online application. Please note that paper applications are *not* accepted. Any employee offered employment must complete the required onboarding paperwork *and* submit valid/ timely state and federal clearances *prior* to the first day of onsite employment. WORK HOUR LIMITATIONS

- Full-time, non-exempt employees may *not* be assigned nor accept any position outlined in this document *if* such work, combined with their regular weekly working hours, exceeds 40 hours per week except as expressly approved by the Board of School Directors.
- Part-time, exempt employees may *not* be assigned nor accept any position outlined in this document *if* such work, combined with their regular weekly working hours, exceeds 29 hours per week except as expressly approved by the Board of School Directors.
- Ancillary Activities Workers may *not* be assigned nor accept any position outlined in this document *if* the sum of all work exceeds 29 hours per week except as expressly approved by the Board of School Directors.
