I am writing to communicate that the Southern Lehigh School District was notified of the following positive or probable positive case(s) of COVID-19.

Any students or staff who have been deemed a “close contact” ([PA DOH Definition - PAHAN 533](#)) by the PADOH will receive an additional correspondence from **BOTH** the **SLSD** and the **PADOH** with further guidance on what to do next. Under these guidelines, students and staff who are deemed a “close contact” of persons with COVID-19 will follow the guidance in the [SLSD Isolation / Quarantine Close Contact Information](#).

The SLSD continues to work with the Pennsylvania Department of Health (PADOH) in all matters related to COVID-19. **To that end, the Pennsylvania Department of Health IS NOT recommending a closure at Liberty Bell.** All spaces will continue to be deep cleaned nightly using [EPA List N](#) products approved for use against SARS-CoV-2 according to label directions. Please note that the PADOH has established the following [COVID-19 School Closures Metrics](#) for the 2021 - 2022 school year. These school closure metrics are tied to the population of students and staff in each respective school building and the number of cases of COVID-19 in a school building during a 14 day period of time.

Staff and students **MUST** continue to complete the [Daily Health Screener](#) and stay home when sick. Further, staff and students **MUST** notify the SLSD Nursing Team immediately if they are experiencing [symptoms related to COVID-19](#) or are a confirmed case of COVID-19. All SLSD students and staff must continue to closely monitor themselves for any sign of illness related to COVID-19 and seek medical guidance as needed.
