Health and Safety Plan Summary

<p style="text-align: center;">Social Distancing</p> 	<p>SLSD will ensure social distancing at a minimum of 6 ft in all instructional spaces. The district will maximize the amount of space between students and reduce the amount of time that they are in close contact with each other in non-instructional spaces using PDE and PA DOH recommendations.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Hygiene Practices</p> 	<p>SLSD expects all students and staff to adhere to personal hygiene practices set forth by the CDC and PA DOH including handwashing, sanitizing, and appropriate respiratory etiquette. The district will provide training and reminders to staff and students on these practices.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Daily Wellness Screener</p> 	<p>Prior to leaving home, SLSD students and staff are required to complete a daily COVID-19 Screener that includes a temperature check. Any staff or students experiencing COVID-19 symptoms must follow the guidance present on the screener and should NOT report to school/work.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">School Visitors</p> 	<p>A moratorium will be placed on all non-essential visitors and volunteers for the duration of the pandemic. Essential visitors will be required to wear a face covering at all times and complete a daily COVID-19 Screener prior to entry. When possible, traditional school meetings will be completed virtually.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Face Coverings</p> 	<p>Per the Secretary of the Pennsylvania Department of Health's Universal Face Covering Order (November 17, 2020), all Southern Lehigh School District students are required to wear a mask or face covering AT ALL TIMES while at school, even when six feet of social distance can be achieved unless a student with disabilities whose IEP or 504 teams have granted an exception.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Transportation</p> 	<p>Students riding SLSD transportation must wear a mask or face coverings AT ALL TIMES in accordance with the PA DOH's Universal Masking Order. SLSD will decrease the number of students on the bus to two students per seat, load the bus from the back to front, and disinfect high-touch surfaces. Parent drop-off/pick-up at school is encouraged.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Cleaning & Disinfecting</p> 	<p>All SLSD cleaning, sanitizing, and disinfecting will be performed in accordance with current CDC and PA DOH guidelines using EPA approved products for use against SARS-CoV-2 to mitigate the spread of communicable diseases. All staff using cleaning, sanitizing, or disinfecting products will receive appropriate training on use.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">School Meals</p> 	<p>SLSD will implement alternate meal serving methods and utilize additional spaces in school buildings to promote social distancing during school lunch periods. Students will be seated in cafeteria spaces facing the same direction while following established social distancing recommendations of 6 ft.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Symptoms At School</p> 	<p>Students or staff showing signs of illness will be separated and sent home immediately. If a case of COVID-19 is confirmed, SLSD staff will consult PA DOH guidance specific to contact tracing, COVID-19 testing, quarantine requirements, community communications, and possible school closures.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Teaching & Learning</p> 	<p>Utilize the parent/guardian feedback data from the Required SLSD Return to School Decision Form to ensure academic consistency and quality instructional outcomes, while providing several options for all students.
