- Students should arrive IN SHIFTS according to last names to avoid a backlog at the start of the parade.

 - LAST NAMES: F-K: 6:15 PM
 - LAST NAMES: L- Q: 6:30 PM
 - LAST NAMES: R-Z: 6:45 PM
- ALL CARS ENTER through the JPLIS entrance off of Route 378 and drive through the bus loop to start to line up
