<u>ALLERGIES and SPECIAL CONSIDERATIONS.</u> After talking with your child's teacher, please contact the health room.

- <u>Teachers/Homeroom Parents</u> please remember one (1) week prior to each party/celebration a menu must be submitted to the NURSES office for review. The menu may only contain 1 unhealthy treat (i.e. cupcake, brownie, Rice Krispie treat etc.). If you need a menu template please contact your classroom teacher.
- NO HOMEMADE FOODS All food products-must be store bought and they must have the ingredients attached. These items must be sent into school 48 hours prior to the party/celebration (handed into the health room to be checked), the only exception to this rule is fresh fruit and veggies-- if these items are being cut/prepared they must be brought into the school the day of the party/celebration and checked by the health room, then they may be cut/prepared with knifes etc. from our cafeterial
- <u>Birthday treats</u> are to be NON EDIBLE, even if being sent home with students. *If* treat bags are found to contain a food item(s), you will be contacted and will need to pick the bags up at school. Thank you for your cooperation!
