

Dear Parents/Guardians or Staff Member:

The Pennsylvania Department of Health has notified the Southern Lehigh School District that as a result of the number of cases of COVID-19 within the Rolling 14 Day Period at Joseph P. Liberati Intermediate School that the school building will be required to close for in-person instruction for three days. Since no students were physically present at JPLIS on Friday, March 26th, the PADOH has stated that the closure can retroactively begin on **Friday, March 26th and run through Sunday, March 28th**. The DOH requires this targeted closure to ensure that the necessary case investigation, contact tracing, and quarantine communications are complete.

Joseph P. Liberati Intermediate School will reopen for in-person Instruction on Monday, March 29th at which time the COVID-19 case counts in the Rolling 14 Day Period at JPLIS will reset to zero.

Students and staff **MUST** continue to complete the <u>Daily Health Screener</u> and stay home when sick or while awaiting COVID-19 test results. Further, staff and students **MUST** notify the SLSD Nursing Team immediately if they are experiencing symptoms related to COVID-19 or are a confirmed case of COVID-19. All SLSD students and staff must continue to closely monitor themselves for any sign of illness related to COVID-19 and seek medical guidance as needed. The Pennsylvania Department of Health provides the following guidance specific to the symptoms of <u>COVID-19</u>.
