## ATHLETIC STADIUM ENHANCEMENTS

## WHERE WE'RE AT:

**Excavation**, **clearing**, and **construction** of the upper drainage basin have reached completion without issue. Connection to the main drainage lines coming from the stadium field was completed and the area has been landscaped to include plantings depicted below.

As the project continues our goal is to communicate, the project's progress with periodic updates designed to capture important elements of major work performed. **Footings and Piers** to accommodate the new bleachers and Press box are continuing and expected to be ready for installation by mid-July. This will include independent third party inspections along with code compliance inspections through Keycodes and Hannover Engineering on behalf of the district and Upper Saucon Township.
