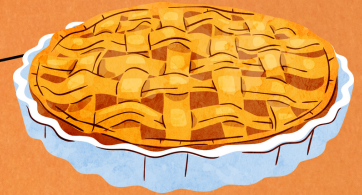
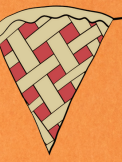


HOPEWELL HAPPENINGS

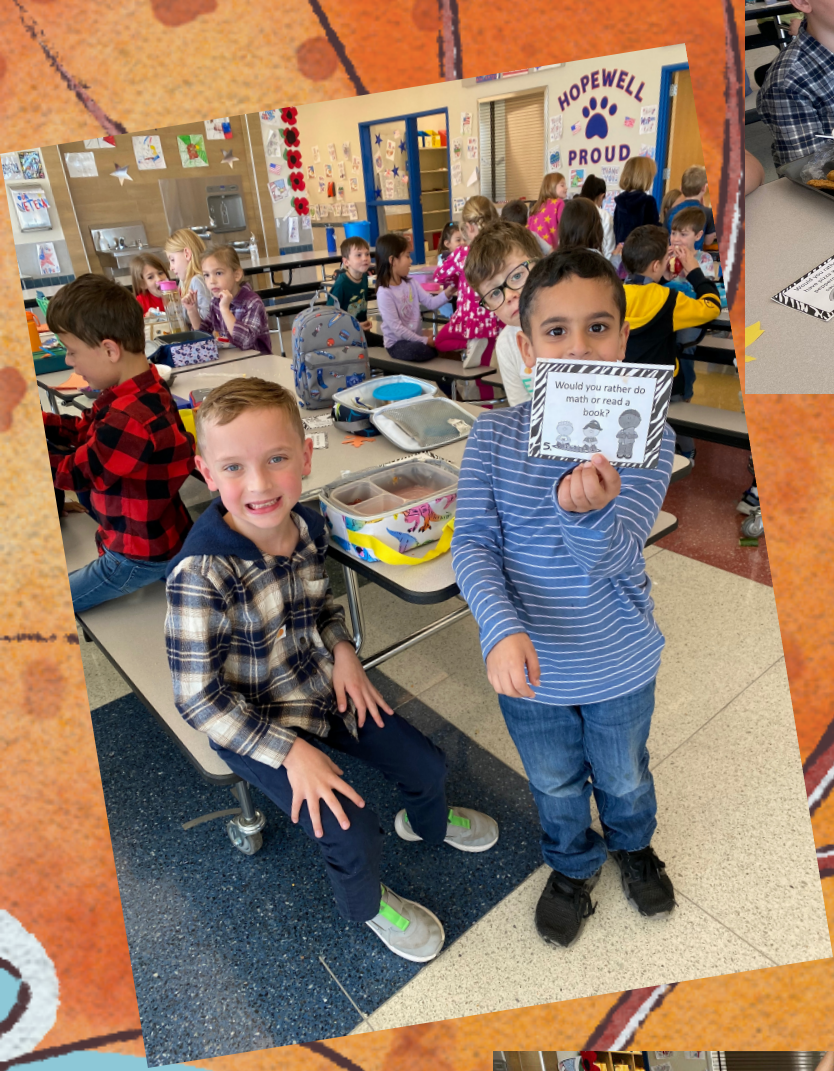
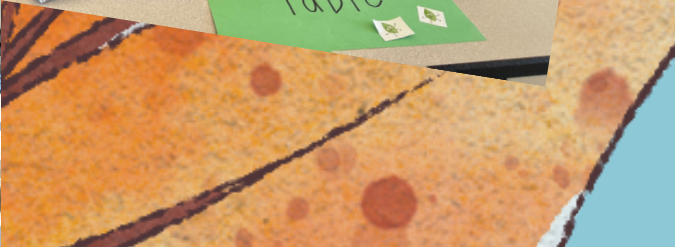
