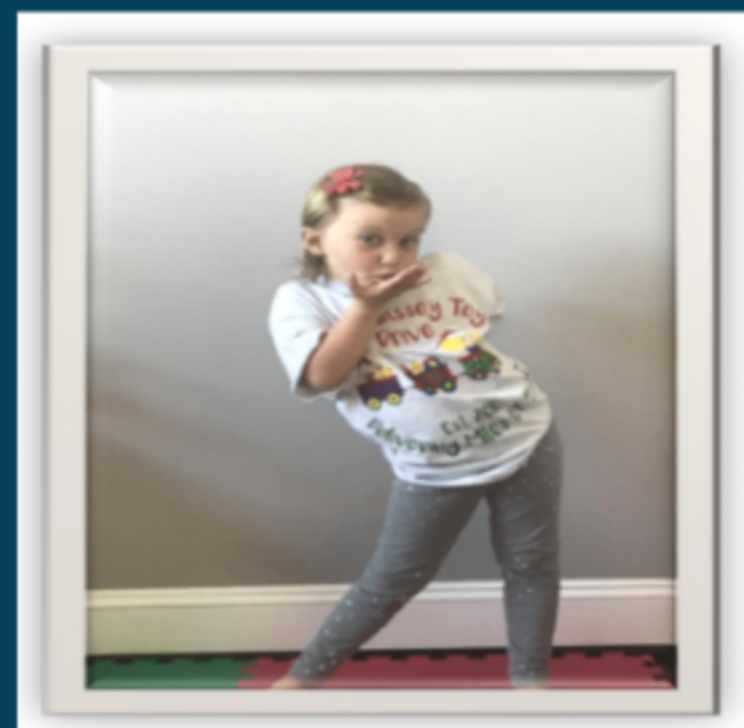


# Sassy Massey Toy Drive
