Dear Hopewell Families,

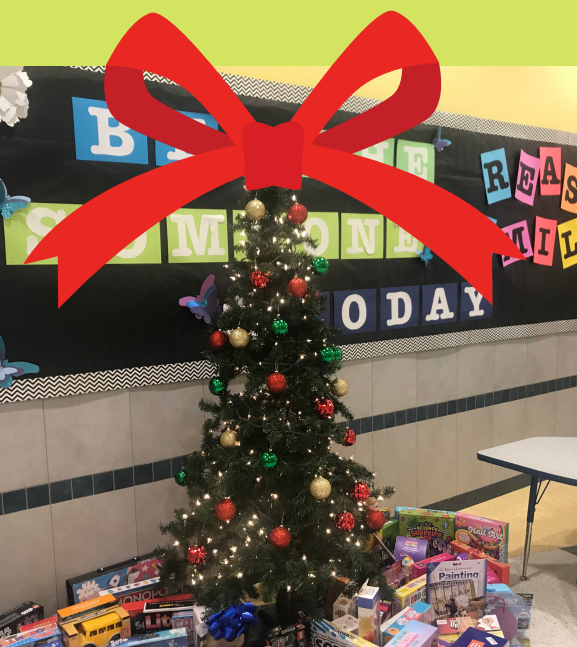

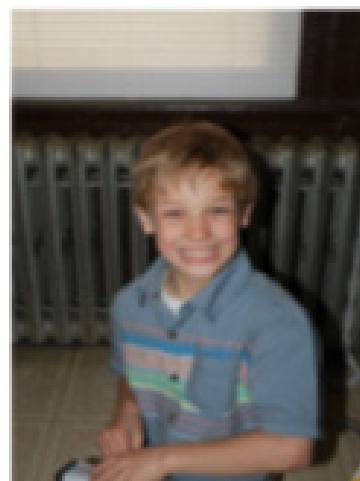
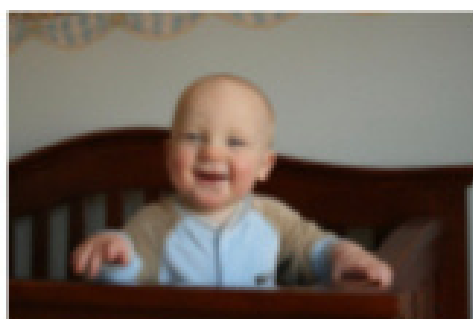
It's Your 3rd Grader's Time to Shine!
