
The Hopewell PTA board nomination period is open for the 2023-24 school year! If you are interested in serving our school on the executive board, please consider one of these positions.

Liberty Trails Summer Camp offers kids something new each day! The adventure begins at Liberty Bell Elementary School where participants will learn background information about the day's experience. Then it's off to the buses! Previously, students have visited Adventure Aquarium, Ashland Coal Mine, Sandy Hook National Recreation Area, Hawk Mountain, Lancaster County, Crystal Cave, Jacobsburg State Park, Tannersville Bog, and more. Included in the L3-day camp is a 2-night cabin camping experience at Pocono Environmental Education Center. Historical, geographical, environmental, and cultural themes are woven into this program. This camp is designed for students currently in 2nd through 6th grades.

The camp meets at **Liberty Bell Elementary** from **June 13 - June 30**. Most days will begin at 8:00 am and end between 3:00 and 5:00 pm depending upon the destination. There will be a Parent Orientation meeting in the evening on May 24, at which time a detailed schedule will be given but. Those that register will be contacted with the date once it's scheduled. We also encourage our parents to sign up as chaperones! It's a great experience for adults as well! Be sure your clearances are on file with the school district.
