

# LIBERTY TRAILS SUMMER CAMP



**June 14 – July 1, 2022**

**Students currently in grades 2 - 6**

*Are you interested in adventure & exploration?  
Do you like field trips?*

**Liberty Trails Summer Camp** offers kids something new each day! The adventure begins at Liberty Bell Elementary School where participants will learn background information about the day's experience. Then it's off to the buses! Previously, students have visited Adventure Aquarium, Ashland Coal Mine, Sandy Hook National Recreation Area, Hawk Mountain, Lancaster County, Crystal Cave, Jacobsburg State Park, Tannersville Cranberry Bog, and more. Included in the 13-day camp is a 2-night cabin camping experience at Pocono Environmental Education Center. Historical, geographical, environmental, and cultural themes are woven into this program. This camp is designed for students currently in 2<sup>nd</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> grades.

The camp meets at **Liberty Bell Elementary** from **June 14 - July 1**. Most days will begin at 8:00 am and end between 3:00 and 5:00 pm depending upon the destination. It is the responsibility of the parent/guardian to provide transportation to and from Liberty Bell Elementary during the program. Students who have not previously participated in the Liberty Trails Summer Camp will be given first priority to attend. The cost for the 13-day program is **\$400 per student**. Registration is open for Southern Lehigh School District students. Maximum of 50 students.

There will be a Parent Orientation meeting in the evening on May 31, at which time a detailed schedule will be given out. Those that register will be contacted with the date once it's scheduled. We also encourage our parents to sign up as chaperones! It's a great experience for adults as well! Be sure your clearances are on file with the school district.
