- If your child needs prescribed medication during the school day, you will need to print and have a physician sign the SLSD Health form to send in (page 4/14).
- If your child has allergies or special dietary needs, you will need to print and send in the Medical plan of care for school food service (page 5/15).
- The free and reduced school meal family application can be found on page (15/15). Although lunches will be free this year, the benefit eligibility can apply to other state programs.
