FAQs

Is this a free service?

Yes, this is a free service provided by the National Honor Society members. The members will earn service hour credit which cannot be earned if they are making money for an activity.

Are your tutors trained?

Yes, our tutors have all completed a training video teaching them how to communicate with their tutee, help with organization and note taking, and provide academic support.

Do I (the parent) need to supervise my child during the session?

You know your child best. We do not require nor do we prohibit parental supervision.

Where will these be offered?

These sessions will be offered through Zoom.

How can I access the Zoom link?

Links will be sent out when you sign up for a session. The link will be sent from solehinhs@slsd.org.

How many tutors will be in each session?

We expect 5 tutors in each session, but it could vary depending on the subject and time.

How many tutees will be in each session?

There are an unlimited number of slots available. Break out rooms will be utilized by the tutors if there are a lot of students. Break out rooms will allow for better tutor to tutee ratios if needed.

What if my child is in Spanish Immersion?

If your child is enrolled in Spanish Immersion, sign up for the English group session. There will be a breakout room for Spanish Immersion students.

What if I want my child to have a 1-on-1 tutoring session like they do at the high school?

If we have a surplus of tutors, we will establish a 1-on-1 system for the other schools. You are welcome to reach out to one of the tutors from the group session to set up a private tutoring session. If you want more help on this, please email solehinhs@sbsd.org.

Will these sessions be supervised?

At least one NHS officer will be checking in every tutoring session for the first week. Otherwise, the high school student tutors in the session will be in charge.
