  - Pass all SL required courses (found on [Profile](#))
- Successful completion of Graduation Project
- Completion of graduation pathway via either:
  - *Proficient* on Keystone Exams
    - Algebra, Biology, Literature

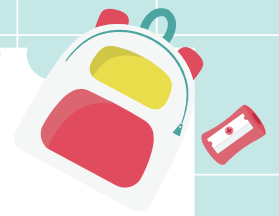


# SENIOR YEAR - SCHEDULE

- MINIMUM 7.0 credits
  - 1.0 English
  - 1.0 Math or Science
  - 0.5 PE
  - 4.5 Other Credits
- NOTE: it is recommended that college bound students take 4 years of Math, Science, Social Studies, & World Language

  - English

# DUAL ENROLLMENT - 2 OPTIONS

## ○ On campus:

- SLHS course that doubles as college course = dual enrollment
  - Fee associated with earning the college credit
- [Courses at SLHS](#) (pgs 14-16 in Program of Studies)
  - Information is provided in class at the beginning of the school year or semester

## ○ Off campus:

- Courses at local colleges
  - High School Scholars Program
  - Emerging Health Professionals program
  - Animal Science program
- **Dual Enrollment meeting will be held on *Friday, March 4th* for students interested in dual enrollment senior year**



# DCO- DIVERSIFIED CAREER OCCUPATIONS

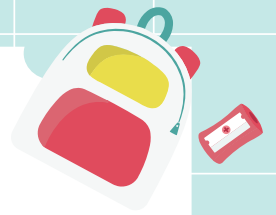


- Must work a minimum of 15 hours per week
- Receive elective credit towards graduation (full year 3.0, half year 1.5)
- Usually 2 blocks – AM or PM
- Required weekly meetings at SLHS with DCO coordinator from LCTI
- Complete assignments relating to work skills
- Must provide own transportation
- **Informational meeting in May for interested students**
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# SENIOR PRIVILEGE

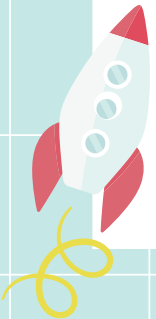


- Reward for Seniors
- Academic, Behavioral & Attendance components
- Must take 7.0 credits
- Takes the place of a block 1 or 4 study hall in schedule
  - Schedule changes to accommodate senior privilege are not permitted
- Application due Spring 2022



# SCHEDULE CHANGE POLICY

- Changes processed through July 1<sup>st</sup>
- After July 1<sup>st</sup>, changes must be requested on the “[Drop/Add Form](#)” and will go before the schedule change committee for a decision
- Semester courses will not be dropped after Sept. 15<sup>th</sup>
- Full year courses will not be dropped after Sept. 30<sup>th</sup>

- ALL students select a **minimum 7.0 credits**
  - Adjustments for: DCO, Emerging Health, Animal Science, Senior Privilege or off campus Dual Enrollment courses are made later in the process
- Students interested in Summer Acceleration **MUST** take a FULL schedule of 8.0 credits and complete the [Course Planning Document](#)

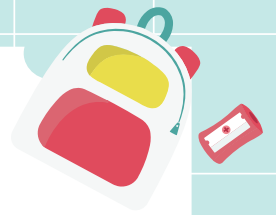

1. Look at SLHS list of NCAA-approved courses on the [Eligibility Center's website](#)
  - a. Enter SL school code: 390830 for a complete list of approved courses
2. Create account on [eligibilitycenter.org](http://eligibilitycenter.org)
3. Take the ACT or SAT and submit scores to the NCAA (utilize free score send!)
