



Southern Lehigh SAT Preparation Test and Course Offerings

SAT TEST: Two SAT Tests will be administered at Southern Lehigh High School this school year on **October 6, 2012 and March 9, 2013**. In preparation for these two tests, we will offer preparation courses in the fall and in the spring. Students can participate in either the CR/Writing or Math course or they can participate in both. If you wish to take the actual SAT test, please register on-line at www.collegeboard.org or through the mail. Forms are available in the guidance office.

WHEN: Fall classes will be offered on Tuesday and Thursday after school from 3:00-5:00p.m. with a practice test scheduled for Saturday morning, September 8th. Classes begin on September 4 and conclude on October 4. A pre-test will be given on Saturday morning, **September 8 in the High School**.

EXPECTATIONS: Attendance will be taken. Students are expected to come to class on time and prepared. A parent e-mail or phone call is expected if students will be absent, tardy, or must leave early. E-mail and phone numbers will be verified and the parent or guardian will be contacted regarding inappropriate student behavior or attendance.

WHERE: Southern Lehigh High School

COST: \$50 per student/course (\$100 for both classes) – this price includes the preparation book
