• Intermediate School Brick Update:

Mr. Breslin explained that he has used Watsontown brick for many years, they will work with him to repair the brick. The brick is given an ASTM rating, severe weather, however it is not acting as that. He believes that the freezing and thawing over the winter has caused the face of the brick to come off. Those brick will be replaced and watched though out the summer to ensure that the problem has been corrected. Letter from Watsontown Brick Company is attached.

• PPL Energy Efficient Lighting Replacement Grant:

The Federal government requires electric companies apply a surcharge to all electric bills for energy awareness and conservation activities. PPL did not meet their goal so they offered all public entities a onetime offering that began April 1 with full completion and billing required by May 9th. Each electric account would be given product and installation at no charge with included 10 LED wall packs, 10 LED exit signs and 10 occupancy sensors. Total value to SLSD = \$35,525

• Liberty Bell Sidewalks & Drive:

There has been very little interest in project. The schedule is running late. Mr. Bergey will be calling other contractors to find out if they are interested in bidding the project. If no more interest is seen, the project may be cancelled.
