Academic Proficiency:

- AP- 1; AP-2 High School and Middle School site visit by Successful Practices Network coach - Oct 12 (HS) Nov. 3 (MS).
- AP-1; AP-3; AP-8 Middle School teachers /departments continue work of reviewing examinations for Standards, Anchors, Eligible Content
- AP-2; AP-8 SLHS students working with elementary to collect books for the Cops and Kids Literacy program during the months of November and December
- AP-2 IC-4;: Parent visitation Day occurred at elementary buildings 11/5/09
- AP-2; HQT-2: Hopewell held a Halloween Parade for parents in the community and to raise fund for Costumes for a Cause to benefit Camelot House on 10/30/09
- AP-2/HQT-2: Discipline Team will be attending their second SWPBS Training next Thursday, November 12th, at CLIU #21 in Schnecksville. The team has developed the expected behaviors in non-classroom settings and is sharing it with respective stakeholders throughout the school environment for feedback and suggestions.
