Academic Proficiency:

- AP 1.1: All students have been taking the PSSAs. Specialized building schedules are being utilized for all portions of the test in an effort to maximize the testing opportunity/time for our students.
- AP 2.1, 2.5: Mr. Markley led the Liberty Bell 3rd Grade spring play, *Munchkin Mediation*, on Friday, March 9th. Over 70 of Liberty Bell 3rd Grade students held a role in the performance.
- AP 2.1: Lower Milford's Second Grade Reading Club held an event coordinated by PTA and Teachers to encourage the love of reading. The event features crafts/activities, story time, and the children choose a book to take home compliments of PTA.
- AP 2.2: PTA sponsored a HW family social on 3/16/12 to promote student and family involvement.
- AP 2.3: "Bully-proof Your Life Assembly", focusing on positive decision-making skills, was held as part of Lower Milford's monthly Schoolwide Positive Behavior program.
