  - 5. We are still looking for a President for the PTA for next year.
- B. Vice President's Report (Allison Cawley)
  - 1. Kidstuff Fundraiser was very successful. The sale is over and we have reached our budget. There are 34 books that have not been returned/paid for. We made about \$2,400 from this sale.
  - 2. Race for Education is still being discussed. The race may be held at Lower Milford.
- C. Treasurer's Report (Jennifer Hedden)
  - 1. Memberships are now at 85 members and still getting more in.
  - 2. The t-shirt sale is doing well. We have sold \$940 worth of T-shirts.
