We can't believe the children are in their 3^{rd} marking period! With the upcoming PTA events in the months ahead, the time will go fast.



A message from the Principal...

Dear Hopewell families:

Welcome to February! We will be celebrating our 100th day of school this Friday

February, 3rd! Time is passing by quickly. Below is a lot of information about upcoming events and some important reminders. Thank you in advance for your continued support of the PTA and our school.

2017-18 Kindergarten Registration: Southern Lehigh School District will be holding kindergarten registration the week of April 3rd, 2017, at *Liberty Bell Elementary School. Beginning March 1, 2017, appointments may be made by signing up electronically on the website under Kindergarten Registration. All registrations will be scheduled as individual appointments. Children must accompany parents to kindergarten registration. Children must be five years old before September 1, 2017 in order to be registered for kindergarten. For more information visit Kindergarten Registration on the slsd.org website. Please share this message with parents who have a child starting kindergarten in the fall.

Third Grade PSSA Math and ELA assessment dates:

All third grade students will be participating in the PSSA Math and English Language \underline{A} rts assessments in April. This year the assessments will be given in two separate weeks. The assessment for English Language Arts will begin on Monday, April 3rd - April 7th. Math Assessments will begin Monday, April 24th- April 28th. Please mark these very important testing dates on your calendar and avoid scheduling appointments or being absent from school on these dates. If your child is absent from school and is unable to make up this assessment during the assessment window, their absence will be considered unexcused. The PSSA is a state mandated assessment.

Attendance requirements: Section 1333 of the School Laws of Pennsylvania requires children to attend school daily, unless ill. Your child's attendance rate also affects our School Performance Profile. Students who are absent or tardy 10 days or more will receive a warning letter that indicates their child's absenteeism rate is approaching the excessive mark. A physician's excuse may be required for each and every future absence.

School board policy necessitates a parental or physician's written excuse be turned in whenever a child returns to school from being absent. This excuse is due within three days of each absence. Please get in the habit of sending an excuse with your child on their first day back to school.

Whenever you have any medical information that affects your child's attendance, this confidential information should be shared directly to our school nurse,

Mrs. Nickie Castetter if it has academic implications.

Arrival and Dismissal safety: Hopewell staff begins to monitor the front door and parent drop off area beginning at 8:40 AM. Please do not drop off your child unsupervised before 8:40AM. Staff are present to assist with student drop off. Please follow their direction. For student safety, children are expected to exit on the passenger side of your car only.

Late starts and early dismissal reminder: When there is a two hour delay, school starts at 11AM. Children may be dropped off beginning at 10:40 AM and not before.

Special note to kindergarten parents: When we have an early dismissal, the rule to follow is that AM kindergarten students will most likely need to remain at school and be dismissed with the rest of our students. If we dismiss after lunch, your AM kindergarten child will be provided a lunch. The reason this is standard practice is because our bus company, Brandywine transportation, also provided transportation to LCTI in Schnecksville and they must have time to return to Southern Lehigh to transport our secondary students before we dismiss our elementary students. It's hard to anticipate the exact time your child will be arriving home, because the dismissal time will differ for each inclement weather early dismissal. Please plan on this practice for future early dismissals. We appreciate your understanding and flexibility as these days are challenging to everyone!

Valentine's Day celebrations: Hopewell School will celebrate Valentine's exchange in the classrooms on Tuesday, February 14th. Individual classrooms may plan additional classroom activities. Due to food allergies that may exist in our classrooms, we ask that you not attach any food or candy to Valentines. Non-edible treats are recommended.
