A Note From Our Principal

Happy November Hopewell Families!

October has been a very busy month for us at Hopewell School.

We'd like to recognize and thank Upper Saucon Fire Company for their student assembly. Important topics shared with our students were: 911 for emergencies, Stop, Drop, Roll & Cover your face, never play with matches, E.D.I.T.H. (meeting place for once outside the home), Crawl Low in Smoke, Fire fighters are your friends and community helpers.

Thank you Fire Chief Chuck Castetter, Lieutenant John Meaney, and firefighters Garrick Borascius, Anthony Chirumbolo, Brianna Prince and Nickie Castetter (also our HW Nurse!) for sharing such important safety information with our students. We are fortunate to have them as our neighbor. Please ask your child about the important safety information they learned to reinforce their fire safety message.

Please remember to replace your smoke alarm batteries whenever you change your clocks in the spring and fall (October 31st).

School Bus Safety: National School Bus Safety Week was October 19-23rd. Please take some time to have a discussion with your child about bus safety responsibilities. Students are reminded daily by our dismissal team to follow the Hopewell CARES "Be Nice – Be Safe" responsibilities while riding on our school buses.

- 1) Be Nice: Students are responsible for speaking in quiet, friendly voices to the child they share a seat with, making sure their words make others feel comfortable and not uncomfortable.
- 2) Be Safe: Students are responsible for sitting safely in their seat, facing forward, keeping hands, feet and objects to themselves. No one has the right to tell anyone where they can or cannot sit. Students are responsible for remaining in the same seat until they get safely to school or safely home.

Please be advised we encourage kindergarten students to sit near the front, all first graders must sit directly behind kindergarten, second graders should sit near the middle and third graders may sit near the back. The bus driver will make seating adjustments and in some cases assign seats as necessary for the safe operation of their school bus.

Parent follow-up and reinforcement of our expectations is appreciated and necessary to help keep our buses and our students safe.

Blackboard Connect: Blackboard Connect is our district's electronic communication system for informing families of school activities and weather related emergencies. Parents can update the Blackboard Connect Parent Portal anytime your contact information changes. Visit the parent link on *slsd.org*, and select Blackboard Connect Web Portal. Read the directions carefully and click on the link to create an account. Please update this information anytime your phone number or email changes. You must also notify the school office and our transportation when any of your contact or student emergency contact information changes.

School safety: The district continues to take great steps in making all schools secure facilities. Please remember all students must have a note from parents to be picked up from school by anyone they do not reside with. We ask that custodial parents notify the school in writing or by phone call if they are granting permission for a non-custodial parent or relative to pick up their child at school. Schools must be kept up to date with visitation information and court orders that identify custody arrangements. Please update our office whenever these arrangements change.

Classes are in session daily until 3:20 PM, therefore we cannot open our doors for parent pick-up until this time. We ask that you to plan accordingly as the weather gets cooler. Please note that parent pick-ups are asked to park around the back of Hopewell School in order to keep bus traffic and pedestrian traffic separate. Please enter the school through the front doors, report directly to the cafeteria, sign out your child at their grade level table, and exit through the rear doors of the gymnasium. Please do not prop open the gymnasium doors when you exit. We also ask parents to wait in the cafeteria at the grade level table and not in the lobby. Please remind your child they may not leave the cafeteria without the grownup that is signing them out. If you are running late, please call the school. This process runs smoothly when we all work together. These firm safety rules are for the benefit of our children. We ask for your compliance.

School pictures were taken on 10/6: An additional makeup day is scheduled for November 18th for any absences or retakes. Parents will receive a reminder notice when this date gets closer. Students who need a retake and are absent on retake day may contact Christmas City directly at 610-691-2109.
