A Note From Our Principal

Dear Hopewell Families:

Welcome to November! This past month has been a busy month at Hopewell School.

We held a very successful Open House on 10/13/16 and a Community Open House, dedication and ribbon cutting ceremony on 10/20/16. We hope you enjoyed seeing the inside of our new school as much as we enjoyed sharing it with you!

Thank you parents and PTA volunteers who contributed to the staff dinner before our Open House. The foods from around the world and theme was greatly appreciated by our teachers!

Parent-Teacher Conference week is November 14- 18. Hopewell School will be using an automated parent-teacher conference scheduler called "SignUpGenius." You already should have received an email directly from your child's teacher to sign up for your parent – teacher conference. If you haven't done so, please click on the link in the email to take you to the sign up page. Just check the box next to the available date and time to select your conference and hit the submit button. You'll receive an email reminder 2 days before your conference. Please call your teacher directly if you do not have an email address.

School Bus Safety: National School Bus Safety Week was October 17-21st. Please take some time to have a discussion with your child about bus safety responsibilities. Students are reminded daily by our dismissal team to follow the Pouncer Pal's expectations and be "Respectful, Responsible, and Ready" while riding on our school buses.

- 1) Respectful students speak in a quiet, friendly voice to the child they share a seat with and make sure their words make others feel comfortable and not uncomfortable.
- 2) Responsible students sit safely in their seat, face forward, and keep hands, feet and objects to themselves. No one has the right to tell anyone where they can or cannot sit. Students are responsible for remaining in the same seat until they get safely to school or safely home.

We encourage kindergarten students to sit near the front, all first graders must sit behind kindergarten, second graders should sit near the middle of the bus and third graders may sit near the back. The bus driver will make seating adjustments as necessary for the safe operation of their school bus. Parent follow-up and regular reinforcement is appreciated and necessary to help keep our buses safe.

School safety: The district continues to take great steps in making all schools secure facilities. Please remember all students must have a note from parents to be picked up from school by anyone they do not reside with. We ask that custodial parents notify the school in writing or by phone call if they are granting permission for a non-custodial parent or relative to pick up their child at school. Schools must be kept up to date with visitation information and court orders that identify custody arrangements. Please update our office whenever these arrangements change.

Classes are in session daily until 3:15 PM; therefore we cannot open our doors for parent pick up until this time. We ask that you to plan accordingly as the weather gets cooler. Please note that parent pick-ups are asked to park in the far right lane of the parent pick up lane. If these spots are full please pull into a parking spot in our parking lot in order for buses to access our bus lane. In order to keep pedestrian traffic and bus traffic separate please exit the lot timely. Please drive carefully at parent drop off and pick up. Young children tend to run and do not always pay attention in our parking lot. We suggest that parents hand-in- hand escort their children to and from our building as drop off and pick up are busy times. These safety expectations will benefit all children.


Missing Sapphire Accounts: All parents are asked to sign up for a Sapphire Account at *slsd.org*. Visit the Parent link on our website and select the Sapphire Community Web Portal. Click on the getting started link. They keyword for getting started is "spartans". Please print, sign and return your application to Elaine Lebo at our Central Office or you may return the application to Hopewell and we will forward it for you. After your application has been received, you will receive an email assigning you a PIN number. You will then be allowed to access the Sapphire Community Portal for report card grades, attendance, and other relevant information.






