E. Tax Assessment Appeals

The Administration recommends approval of the Settlement of two separate, pending Tax Assessment Appeals relating to County-wide reassessment as follows:

Coopersburg II Associates – Lehigh County File No. 2012-C-4335

The assessed value of the property which is the subject of this Appeal, namely, PIN #642357397617, consisting of 2.4003 acres of land together with a two story, 41 unit, senior citizen, apartment building situated thereon and located at 335 E. State Street, Coopersburg, PA 18036, shall be assessed at \$1,400,000, which is 100% of its fair market value, for purposes of assessment of real estate taxes for the years on and after January 1, 2013.

CAMMRA LLC – Lehigh County File No. 2012-C-4932

The assessed value of the property which is the subject of this Appeal, namely, PIN #642323276494, consisting of 115.4 acres of land currently being utilized as golf course property located at 5500 Locust Valley Road, Upper Saucon Township, shall be assessed at \$19,500 per acre or \$2,250,000 (rounded), in the aggregate, which is 100% of its fair market value, for purposes of assessment of real estate taxes for the years on and after January 1, 2013.

The assessed value of two adjoining slivers of property owned by the Petitioner, which are not a part of this Appeal, shall be re-assessed as of August 1, 2013, at \$19,500 per acre for purposes of assessment of real estate taxes for the years on and after January 1, 2014, as follows:

a. <u>PIN #642333180696</u>, consisting of 1.2 acres of land which adjoins the property which is the subject of this Appeal, shall be re-assessed at \$19,500 per acre or \$23,500 (rounded), in the aggregate, which is 100% of its fair market value, for purposes of assessment of real estate taxes on and after January 1, 2014; and

b. <u>PIN #642333</u>186703, consisting of 4.72 acres of land which adjoins the property which is the subject of this Appeal, shall be re-assessed at \$19,500 per acre or \$92,000 (rounded), in the aggregate, which is 100% of its fair market value, for purposes of assessment of real estate taxes on and after January 1, 2014.

The Solicitor is authorized to enter into a Stipulation of Counsel with legal counsel for the other parties involved in the two Appeals for purposes of effectuating the Settlements.
