- The Administrative Team is finalizing plans to kick off the new school year. We have been
 Interviewing for positions, hoping to ensure that we have our new teachers ready to begin the
 school year with students. Board members are invited to attend the Welcome Back breakfast
 and assembly next Tuesday, August 19 if available.
- Our administrative team has also been planning for Induction for new teachers. This begins
 Monday August 18 and Board Members are invited to lunch that day to meet our new
 teachers in the JPLIS cafeteria at 12:00 PM. Please let Diana Millman know if you plan to

- As 2nd graders continue to register, our transportation department has once again tried to balance class sizes in our 3 elementary buildings. At this point we have some classes of 26 and 27. Once school begins and we have a better idea of class sizes we may recommend some additional IA support. Adding another teacher to reduce class sizes does not work well, as children would need to move to a new building, something generally frowned upon by parents.
- The Edu-Summit kicked off today at the high school. Board members are invited to stop by tomorrow if available. Hasselbring (Ed.D.) a Professor of Special Education at Peabody College of Vanderbilt University who spoke on brain research and the power of technology for developing math and language fluency. Tomorrow's keynote will feature Dean Shareski, the Community Manager for Discovery Education Canada. The event has about 230 registered educators including many from Southern Lehigh.
