 Our technology team did a great job of high school laptop distribution. As of today (Monday, Sept. 8), there are 197 laptops housed in the building on carts. The rest (857) are computers going home daily.

In summary:

18.7% of the computers are housed in the building on carts

81.3% are going home daily
