BUSINESS AND FINANCE

Bond Refinancing

Mr. Chris Gibbons from Concord Public Financial Advisors presented a refunding option for the district's 2010 and 2011 General Obligation Bonds. In order to maximize the savings in the refinancing of both bonds, the recommendation is to pursue two separate refinancings-

- 1. Refinance the 2010 Bonds now up to the \$10mm Bank Qualified limit. Current net present savings available is \$349,109 or 3.97% of the refunded principal.
- 2. Refinance the 2011 Bonds on September 12, 2016. Net present value savings available if current interest rates available September 12, 2016 are \$683,096, or 7.87% of refunded principal.

MOVED BY Gehman and 2^{ND} BY Smith to approve the authorization of refinancing the district's General Obligation Bond, Series of 2010 immediately with a minimum savings of 3% and the General Obligation Bond, Series of 2011 upon eligibility.
